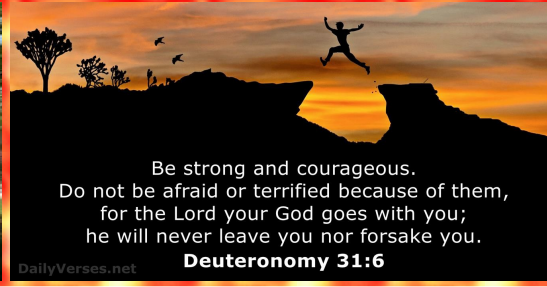

THE HEAT AND THE PANDEMIC, are still with us, and this is our 7th month continuously doing the work of The Father in the community! Here we are in the THREE DIGIT weather!!!! 111 – 113 degrees!! HOT!!! HOT!!! HOT!!!

This month's newsletter is all about the community and how they have appreciated the ministry of our Abundant Life Community Service Team. Our lines have grown tremendously, and the word is spreading all around the community at large. People are even stopping because they see our sign and because they see the lines of people waiting for their opportunity to shop for food. We have all nationalities that have come into the premises to get bags of groceries.

Our system is very simple, YOU SHOP! My team comes together every Wednesday morning around 9:30am (no matter how HOT) to set up tables outside in the parking area of the Community Center. We focus on social distancing so the tables are placed a good distance from each other. Each table is set up accordingly. Vegetable tables may have tomatoes, potatoes, onions, bell peppers, squash, lettuce, eggplant, zucchini etc... Our fruit tables may have strawberries, blueberries, raspberries, bananas, oranges, apples, mangoes, cantelop, papaya, kiwi, plums, peaches, grapes, and more. We have the Water table, which may also have other drinks. We have the Deli table which consist of various dinners (microwaveable) sandwiches, green salads, pasta salads and more. The Desert table with cakes, cookies, pies, snacks, chips, crackers, danish and more. The bread table with loaf breads, french breads, rolls, bagels, chibata bread, begets, hot dog/hamburger buns and more. The dairy table would have milk, eggs, cheese, dips, and more.

Once the tables are all set up around 11am we open the gate for the people to enter 1 person per table until we have reached our limit. Keeping in mind to continue to practice social distancing. Once they enter they are given 2-3 empty bags, (donated by Winco Grocery) to take shopping. We allow them to pick their own food. This strategy is used as to make sure that you are not having to throw away food that you do not eat or want once you arrive home. They fill their bags to the brim and they are good to go! The temperatures are SCREAMING HOT but that does not stop us from serving the community, nor does it stop the community from coming out to be served. Not to mention again that it is HOT! NOONE really wants to deal with these HOT temperatures, we received strength and patience from the HEAVENLY FATHER himself moving on.....

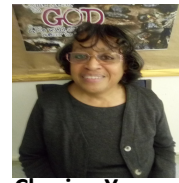
