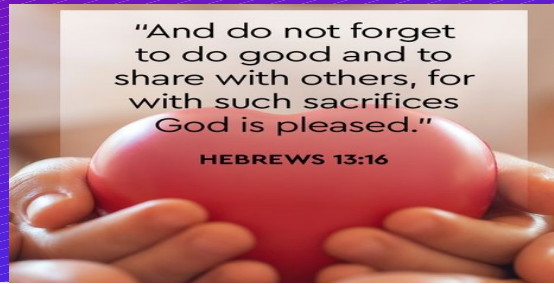


ABUNDANT LIFE COMMUNITY SERVICE
